# **Corporation Update**

Staff provided an update regarding Capitalize Albany Corp.'s Small Business Building Improvement Grant (BIG) Program. The Corporation received just under 100 applications requesting over \$2,000,000, more than three times the funding available. Over 50% of those applications were submitted by disadvantaged business enterprises (DBEs), and multiple applications were submitted for projects in each of the City's five (5) Neighborhood Strategy Areas (NSAs).
