## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED PROJECT AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE RELATING THERETO

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing pursuant to Section 859-a(2) of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York (the "Act") will be held by the City of Albany Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2024 at 12:00 o'clock p.m., local time, at 21 Lodge Street in the City of Albany, Albany County, New York in connection with the following matters:

Forty-Eightcc LLC, a New York State limited liability company (the "Company"), submitted an application (the "Application") to the Agency, a copy of which Application is on file at the office of the Agency, which Application requested that the Agency consider undertaking a project (the "Project") for the benefit of the Company, said Project consisting of the following: (A) (1) the acquisition of an interest in an approximately 5.49 acre parcel of land located at 48 Corporate Circle (tax map no.: 41.00-2-63) in the City of Albany, Albany County, New York (the "Land"), (2) the construction on the Land of an approximately 93,000 square foot building (the "Facility") and (3) the acquisition and installation therein and thereon of related fixtures, machinery, equipment and other tangible personal property (the "Equipment") (the Land, the Facility and the Equipment being collectively referred to as the "Project Facility"), all of the foregoing to be owned and operated by the Company as a warehouse facility with the capacity for possible technology, manufacturing, distribution and warehousing industrial uses and any other directly and indirectly related activities; (B) the granting of certain "financial assistance" (within the meaning of Section 854(14) of the Act) with respect to the foregoing, including potential exemptions from certain sales and use taxes, real property taxes, real estate transfer taxes and mortgage recording taxes (collectively, the "Financial Assistance"); and (C) the lease (with an obligation to purchase) or sale of the Project Facility to the Company or such other person as may be designated by the Company and agreed upon by the Agency.

The Agency is considering whether (A) to undertake the Project, and (B) to provide certain exemptions from taxation with respect to the Project, including (1) exemption from mortgage recording taxes with respect to any documents, if any, recorded by the Agency with respect to the Project in the office of the County Clerk of Albany County, New York or elsewhere, (2) exemption from deed transfer taxes on any real estate transfers, if any, with respect to the Project, (3) exemption from sales taxes relating to the acquisition, construction, renovation and installation of the Project Facility, and (4) in the event that the Project Facility would be subject to real property taxation if owned by the Company but shall be deemed exempt from real property taxation due to the involvement of the Agency therewith, exemption from real property taxes (but not including special assessments and special ad valorem levies), if any, with respect to the Project Facility, subject to the obligation of the Company to make payments in lieu of taxes with respect to the Project Facility. If any portion of the Financial Assistance to be granted by the Agency will follow the Project is not consistent with the Agency's uniform tax exemption policy, the Agency will follow the procedures for deviation from such policy set forth in Section 874(4) of the Act prior to granting such portion of the Financial Assistance.

If the Agency determines to proceed with the Project, the Project Facility will be acquired, constructed, reconstructed and installed by the Agency and will be leased (with an obligation to purchase) or sold by the Agency to the Company or its designee pursuant to a project agreement (the "Agreement") requiring that the Company or its designee make certain payments to the Agency.

The Agency has not yet made a determination pursuant to Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law (the "SEQR Act") regarding the potential environmental impact of the Project.

The Agency will at said time and place hear all persons with views on either the location and nature of the proposed Project, or the Financial Assistance being contemplated by the Agency in connection with the proposed Project. A copy of the Application filed by the Company with the Agency with respect to the Project, including an analysis of the costs and benefits of the Project, is available for public inspection during business hours at the offices of the Agency. A transcript or summary report of the hearing will be made available to the members of the Agency.

1 MS. MOHL: Good afternoon. My name is Ashley Mohl and I'm the CEO and 2 Public Hearing Officer today for the City 3 of Albany Industrial Development Agency, 4 the Agency, in connection with the 5 Project which is the subject of this 6 7 public hearing. Today we are holding this 8 9 public hearing to allow citizens to make a statement, for the record, relating to 10 the involvement of the Agency with a 11 Project, the proposed Project, for the 12 benefit of Forty-Eightcc, LLC, a New 13 York State limited liability 14 corporation. 15 The proposed project involves 16 17 the construction of an approximate 18 93,000 square-foot warehouse/distribution facility on what 19 is currently 8.29 acres of land. 20 21 The current request at hand, and the subject of this public hearing, 22 is the request for additional financial 23 24 assistance sought for certain exemptions 25 from taxation with respect to the

Project including sales and use taxes and mortgage recording taxes. Copies of the notice of this public hearing are available on our website at www.albanyida.com and upon request.

Now, unless there is any objection, I am going to suggest waiving the full reading of the notice of this public hearing, and instead request that the full text of the notice be inserted into the record.

I will also note that general information on the Agency's general authority and public purpose is contained in a separate statement and will be entered into the record.

Before we start the public hearing, I would first like to introduce the Project applicant and ask them to make a few brief remarks with respect to the Project.

MR. GOLDBERG: Good afternoon.

I'm Paul Goldberg for the LLC. We are
looking to develop on 155 in the
corporate park out there. We have

developed all the buildings out there.

The grading is done and we are excited about moving forward with it. If anyone has any questions, it's a warehouse building, similar to all the buildings that are out on Corporate Circle. It's spec'ed only, but we hope it will go well. We are ready to go. We thank the IDA for its patience and we appreciate it. As I said, if you have any questions, we are happy to answer them.

MS. MOHL: I will now open this Public Hearing. The time now is 12:05 pm.

I will note for the record
that there were no written comments
received prior to the meeting today. Per
the notice of this public hearing, the
public was encouraged to submit written
comments prior to today's hearing. A
record of this public hearing will be
prepared and reviewed by the members of
the Agency in connection with
consideration of the proposed Project. A
copy of the record of this public
hearing will be presented to the Mayor

of the City of Albany and members of the Agency.

Again, the purpose of this public hearing is not to field questions, but to solicit public comment. We ask that all speakers observe proper decorum today and individuals who conduct themselves in an inappropriate manner while addressing the Board will be removed and forfeit their opportunity to address the Board today.

At this time, I would like to ask if there is anyone here who wishes to speak on the proposed Project to comment on either on the nature and location of the Project facility, or the proposed financial assistance being contemplated. Any commenters would be limited to three minutes, max.
